Required Documents:

Ontario:

- Secondary/High School Transcript with Ontario Secondary School Diploma completion

Alberta:

- High School Transcript and Advanced High School Diploma completion indication or documentation

British Columbia:

- High School/Secondary transcript with Secondary School Graduation Diploma (also known as “Dogwood Diploma”) completion documentation
