which educators developed non-traditional instruction to provide meaningful learning experiences for students in a virtual format.

"Ms. Munsey had a calm, clear vision of what needed to be done and how to accomplish it," the nomination stated. "She inspired confidence with her no-nonsense decisions that were very effective. The TES leadership team developed a schedule and plan that worked. They incorporated classroom managers that contacted families to provide the equipment, knowledge and skills necessary to help their children log on, and taught them how to turn in homework on Google Classroom. Munsey is beginning her sixth year as principal at Tamarack. Before that, she served for seven years as assistant principal at Tamarack and Highland elementary schools; she was an instructional coach at Burns Middle School for five years, where she additionally taught 8th-grade for seven years. Munsey earned a master's degree and Rank I from Western Kentucky University and is a graduate of Kentucky Wesleyan College, Tallahassee Community College and Daviess County High School.

KAPE executive director Donna House said a committee of KAPE executive board members and administrators reviews nominations from across the Commonwealth each year.

"The committee reviews the nominees to see that they meet the components of the rubric for educators demonstrating the highest qualities of leadership," House said. "Principal Munsey was selected from all the nominees in Kentucky during the annual committee meeting in April."
