Youravich appointed to Kentucky Infrastructure Authority

Hardin County Water District No. 2 General Manager Shaun Youravich has been appointed by the Gov. Andy Beshear for a state commission.

He will serve as a member of the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority, replacing previous member Ronald Lovan who retired.

Youravich said the position serves as a representative for the Kentucky sector of the American Water Works Association, of which he is a member and also serves on the Water Utility Council Committee.

"I'm truly honored to have been selected," he said.

Youravich was one of three names selected by AWWA for this open position because it is required by state regulation. He was ultimately chosen after submitting a resume and background check.

He will finish the remainder of Lovan's term which ends June 30, 2025.

Youravich said he has yet to attend a meeting on the authority, but said the board authorizes the distribution of money through loans and grant approvals at the authority.

"I'm just excited to serve and look forward to it," he said.

Youravich, a Western Kentucky University graduate, has worked at HCWD2 for almost 31 years. He was named general manager in 2020.

He also has served on the Kentucky/Tennessee Section American Water Works Association and Kentucky Water and Wastewater Operators Association.
