

Minutes from the AOL Meeting Feb. 7, 2012

GRADUATE AOL

- The graduate committee received the results from the oral presentations done in the fall 2012 semester.
- AOL committee now needs to measure each graduate goal in each of the three delivery methods for graduate programs.
- A set of volunteers is needed to act as AOL assessors for the goals that are measured each semester. This should be done for both the undergraduate and graduate programs.

The AOL committee makes the following recommendation:

Undergraduate Curriculum Committee

The AOL committee recommends that a group of faculty be identified from each department that will act as an assessor for any undergraduate AOL goal. Four to eight evaluators will be used to assess each goal. Each piece of data would be evaluated by two different assessors but each assessor would only evaluate a portion of the data collected. It is also the recommendation that assessors be members of the AOL Undergraduate Assessment subcommittee.

Graduate Committee

The AOL committee recommends that a group of graduate faculty be identified from each department that will act as an assessor for any graduate AOL goal. Four to eight evaluators will be used to assess each goal. Each piece of data would be evaluated by two different assessors but each assessor would only evaluate a portion of the data collected. It is also the recommendation of the committee that these assessors be members of the AOL Graduate Assessment subcommittee.

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- The committee needs several volunteers to evaluate the graduate ethics data collected last semester.
 - The committee is still waiting on ETS scores from the graduate program
 - Critical thinking is to be evaluated in BA 520 P delivery, BA 590 Online, & Ba 590 FTF.
 - Global Awareness needs to be evaluate this semester in the graduate PMBA program

- Critical thinking and strategic problem solving needs to be measure this semester in MGT 498
- WKUSES questions need to be reviewed to make sure they are consistent with the current goals.
