 - a. The Executive Committee of the Midwestern Association of Graduate Schools (MAGS) is soliciting nominations for the 2022 MAGS/ProQuest Distinguished Master's Thesis Awards. The awards are to recognize and reward distinguished scholarship and research at the master's level. MAGS has adopted the same process as that of the Council of Graduate Schools (CGS) for awarding the Distinguished Master's Thesis Awards in two of four categories that alternate every two years. For the 2022 cycle, MAGS is seeking nominations for the Distinguished Thesis Awards in the two broad categories of the **Biological/Life Sciences and Humanities**.
 - i. The Guidelines for the 2022 MAGS/ProQuest Distinguished Master's Thesis Awards are as follows:
 - ii. Each member institution may submit one nomination for each award category. Each nomination requires the written endorsement of the Dean of the Graduate School or equivalent official. The institution selection process is the responsibility of that individual institution.
 - iii. Nominations will be accepted in the disciplines of Biological/Life Sciences and Humanities in which the institution offers a master's degree. **The effective date of degree award, or the completion of master's degree requirements, must fall in the period of July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021, inclusive, for each nominee selected.** The nomination form, the abstract of the nominated thesis (submitted as a standalone document), and the thesis must be submitted electronically by Monday, November 1, 2021 to MAGS. See the [Awards area of the MAGS website](#) for the nomination process, guidelines, and submission link.
 - iv. Proposals for the MAGS/ProQuest thesis awards are accepted from all MAGS member institutions. However, all award winners must submit their thesis to ProQuest, regardless of their university's use of ProQuest's services.
