Bill 33-23-S.	. Funding for Bike4Alz Team #11.
PURPOSE:	For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to allocate \$500 to Bike4Alz.
WHEREAS:	The funds will come from the Legislative Discretionary budget.
WHEREAS:	Bike4Alz is a registered RSO and 501(C)(3) nonprofit. The goal is to raise money for Alzheimer's research while biking across the country and raising awareness. Along the 3,600-mile trek through 11 states, Bike4Alz will host fundraising events, benefit nights at restaurants, tour Alzheimer's treatment facilities, and meet with patients and their families to better understand the disease.
WHEREAS:	Bike4Alz needs money to purchase tubes for tires, CO2 canisters to be able to quickly refill tires while riding, and a trailer jack. Of the \$500, \$60 will go to a trailer jack, \$368 will go to bike tire tubes, and \$72 will go to CO2 canisters.
