WHEREAS: Sunday, April 23rd will be a campus-wide Out of the Darkness Suicide Awareness walk, and

WHEREAS: Monday, April 24th will be a Coffee and Kindness tabling event, and

WHEREAS: Tuesday, April 25th will be a Grow Your Mind tabling event, and

WHEREAS: Wednesday, April 26th will be a Denim Day tabling event as well as a guest speaker event with

Dr. Jay Gabbard, and

WHEREAS: Thursday, April 27th will be a group yoga class at the Preston Center, and

WHEREAS: Friday, April 28th will be a Dog Day tabling event outside of Centennial Mall, and

WHEREAS: Approximately \$120 will be spent on Monday, \$64 on Tuesday, \$179 on Wednesday, \$100 on

Thursday, and \$87 to plan for unforeseen costs, and

sexual assault awareness, and suicide awareness, and

WHEREAS: This week will also provide students with an opportunity for mental health breaks prior to finals

week as well as working towards destigmatizing mental health.
