Bill 15-23-F. A Bill to Amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to amend its

Constitution.

WHEREAS: The Judicial Council operates as the Judicial Branch, with the Senate as the Legislative

Branch and Executive Cabinet as the Executive Branch, and

WHEREAS: Section 4.6 of the Constitution describes the duties of the Judicial Council, and

WHEREAS: The Judicial Branch requires minimal involvement, and this creates an imbalance in

participation between the three branches, and

WHEREAS: A new section numbered 4.6.9 will be added, reading:

"4.6.9 Maintain two (2) office hours monthly.", and

WHEREAS: A new section numbered 4.6.9.1 will be added, reading:

"4.6.9.1. An office hour may consist of tabling for SGA, meetings with faculty and staff

on issues pertaining to SGA, or time in the SGA office.", and

WHEREAS: All subsequent subsections of Section 4.6 will be renumbered accordingly.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky

University will amend its Constitution.
