WHEREAS: The use of "Outreach and Student Experience Committee" shall be amended to

"Outreach and Public Relations Committee" in sections 2.4.6, 2.7.6, and 3.8.4.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky will amend

its Constitution.
