Bill 5-24-S. Funding for vouchers for the WKU Dental Hygiene Center and ID Center.

- PURPOSE:** For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to allocate \$2,000.00 from the Legislative Voucher Program budget for the fall and spring 2023-2024 WKU ID Center and Dental Hygiene Vouchers.
- (1)WHEREAS: For the fall semester, students used \$955.00 total in vouchers between the ID Vouchers and Dental Hygiene Vouchers, and
- (2)WHEREAS: For the spring semester, there is \$1,045.00 remaining from the Legislative Voucher Program Budget, and
- (3)WHEREAS: For the spring semester, the remainder of the Legislative Voucher Program (\$1,045.00) will be split 62/38 between the Dental Hygiene Clinic and ID Center vouchers. The Dental Hygiene Office will receive \$650.00 and the ID Center will receive \$390.00. This will give 26 vouchers to the Dental Hygiene Office and 39 vouchers to the ID Center, and
- (4)WHEREAS: Through the voucher program, students are able to get a \$10.00 (50%) discount when receiving a new ID and a \$25.00 voucher for completely free services at the Dental Hygiene Clinic, and
- (5)WHEREAS: Students are immediately and positively impacted by the availability of the vouchers that SGA provides. The use of these vouchers enables students to have access to a service that many have trouble affording.
- THEREFORE:** Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University will distribute \$650.00 for the Dental Hygiene Clinic and \$390.00 to the ID Center, for a total of \$1,040.00. The remaining five dollars will be allocated back to the Legislative Discretionary Budget.
