Bill 10-11-F. Funding for the Sustainability Committee's Promotion of "No-Shave November"

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to allocate \$100 from Senate Discretionary for the promotion and implementation of "No-Shave November" during the month of November.

WHEREAS: Although the original intent is for cancer awareness, the environmental impact of these efforts will be tremendous, and

WHEREAS: According to the EPA, 2 billion disposable razors are thrown away each year, and each day, men use 5-10 gallons of water to shave, and the usage of disposable razors contributes over 14.9 pounds of carbon dioxide to the atmosphere per year per person, and

WHEREAS: If all men on WKU's campus participate in "No-Shave November," based on current enrollment, 2.5 Million gallons of water will be saved, along with hundreds of disposable razors,

WHEREAS: The allocated money from Senate Discretionary will be used to facilitate "No-Shave November", and

WHEREAS: All unspent funding will be returned to Senate Discretionary.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western

Kentucky University will allocate \$100 from Senate Discretionary to

promote "No-Shave November."
