Dr. Crews summarized the most recent results from surveying alums as relates to the review of the Core Curriculum.

1. Nothing major leaped out as either good or bad from the surveys.
2. The review committee asks each department to consider some things and report back.
 - a. Is the current core serving your majors?
 - b. How can the core courses in your department be improved?

It is the sense of the committee that survey results will not impact the review of undergraduate learning goals and objectives. Review of the learning objectives will be visited when the college mission has been reviewed which is probably after a new Dean has been hired.
