New Business

Department of Educational Administration, Leadership and Research

•Revise a Program – 098, Specialist in Education: School Administration
There was a Berger/Norman motion to approve/second. Jim Berger presented. These changes are being made to modify admission criteria to reflect new GRE scores and WKU Graduate Studies and Research admission criteria. There were a few minor edits mentioned and noted. The motion passed.

School of Teacher Education

It was agreed to address the following four proposals together:

- Delete Course ELED 445, Introduction to Educational Technology
- •Delete Course ELED 445G, Introduction to Educational Technology
- •Delete Course ELED 508, Foundations and Organization of Early Childhood Education
- ■Delete Course ELED 543, Interactive Teaching Skills

There was a Powers/Berger motion to approved/second. These courses have not been offered for over five years. The motion passed.

It was agreed to address the following two proposals together:

- •Create a New Course GTE 539, Assessment and Identification of Gifted and Talented Children
- •Create a New Course GTE 540, Creativity and Leadership in Gifted Youth

There was a Powers/Berger motion to approve/second. Nielsen Pereira presented. These courses will be a critical component of a master's program in Gifted Education. It was stated that more detailed information should be added to 5.1 under budget implications for proposed method of staffing. The motion passed.

- •Create a New Major Program MAE- Gifted Education and Talent Development
 There was a Haggbloom/Powers motion to approve/second. Nielsen Pereira presented. After some discussion it was realized that some new courses mentioned in this proposal had not been approved. There was a Berger/Powers motion to approve/second that this proposal be postponed definitely to the next meeting. This motion passed.
- •Revise a Program Teacher Admission Policy

There was a Berger/Maxwell motion to approve/second. This proposed policy revision is needed to bring WKU's requirements into alignment with a new state regulation regarding GPA and testing requirement changes required by Kentucky's Education Professional Standards Board. The motion passed.

•Revise a Program - Admission to Student Teaching Policy
There was a Berger/Norman motion to approve/second. The revision is for undergraduate programs only. This proposed policy revision is needed to bring WKU's requirements into alignment with a new state regulation regarding field experience (clinical) hours as specified by Kentucky's Education Professional Standards Board.
