Admission Requirements:

1. Must meet the minimum admission requirements of the Office of Graduate Studies.
2. Must have three years of teaching experience at the appropriate level. Up to two years of experience may be waived in favor of equivalent experience.
3. Must submit four letters of recommendation: Two from graduate faculty members and two from professional associates in administrative and/or supervisory roles.
