

Personal income last published on November 16, 2021.

Hart is one of 120 counties in Kentucky. It is not part of a metropolitan area. Its 2020 population of 19,013 ranked 62nd in the state.

**Note:** 2020 population estimates do not incorporate the results of the 2020 Census. BEA will incorporate the Census Bureau's population estimates based on the 2020 Census results when they become available.

#### Per Capita Personal Income


In 2020, Hart had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,418. This PCPI ranked 87th in the state and was 79 percent of the state average, \$47,339, and 63 percent of the national average, \$59,510. The 2020 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.3 percent from 2019. The 2019-2020 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.2 percent. In 2010, the PCPI of Hart was \$26,009 and ranked 90th in the state. The 2010-2020 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 3.5 percent and for the nation was 3.9 percent.

#### Personal Income


In 2020, Hart had a personal income of \$711,433\*. This personal income ranked 63rd in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 2010, the personal income of Hart was \$472,943\* and ranked 66th in the state.

#### Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Local Area

In 2019, Hart produced \$601,862 in current-dollar total GDP\*. This GDP ranked 55th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 2009, the total GDP of Hart was \$362,946 and ranked 67th in the state.

In 2019, Hart real GDP grew 1.0 percent; the 2018-2019 state change was 1.8 percent. The 2009-2019 compound annual growth rate for Hart real GDP was 3.1 percent; the compound annual growth rate for the state was 1.4 percent.

## **Industry Composition**

Goods- and services-producing industries and government comprise total GDP. Industry statistics reflect the value of goods and services produced by each of those industries located in Hart. In 2019, goods-producing industries produced the largest portion of GDP, while services-producing industries and government produced the second and third largest portion of GDP, respectively.
