***Required for Admission before a Proficiency Evaluation Committee may be formed:***

1. Letter of interest including experience and statement of goals
2. Three letters of recommendation to the program  
(Letter of interest and three recommendation letters should demonstrate the candidate's dispositions for teaching including creativity, collaboration, and communication skills.)
3. [Two Criminal Background Checks via Verified Credentials and KY CAN \(Child Abuse Neglect\)](#)
4. [Physical Exam reported on the KY Department of Education Medical Form](#)
5. TB Skin Test Report (may not be needed if no risk factors are noted on the Medical Form)
6. [Signed KY Code of Ethics](#)
7. Passing scores on the required **Praxis Core (CASE)**. *When taking the exams, the candidate should request the Educational Testing Service report scores directly to WKU Code R1901.*
8. Transcript(s) from all undergraduate and graduate coursework showing a Baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution
9. **Minimum GPA of 3.0 in the last 30 hours** of attempted course work or a **2.75 GPA overall**
10. A **minimum GPA of 2.75 in the major**
11. \$250 application fee (money order or cashier's check made payable to WKU)

***Other Important Admission Information:***

\*This application is the first step in the Proficiency Evaluation Process. A digital portfolio will need to be submitted for the committee to review before an Educator Learning Plan may be written in support of a conditional teaching certificate or a full recommendation for a provisional certificate.

\* Both the **Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) PRAXIS, and PRAXIS II Content** examinations for the desired certification area must be submitted by the completion of the **first 15 hours of coursework**. If no coursework is required by the Proficiency Evaluation Committee, the **PLT, and PRAXIS II** examinations for the desired certification area must be submitted prior to the recommendation for certification.
