- In order to be well prepared for the MCAT, you are encouraged to complete courses in cell biology, microbiology, statistics, psychology, and sociology.
- Applicants must receive a letter grade of C or higher for all required prerequisite courses.
- Note: Some schools do not accept AP credit. Consult with your advisor to ensure all prerequisites courses and experience requirements are met by your senior year.
- Competitive applications to these programs usually include some degree of extracurricular activities.

Steps to Medical School	MCAT Registration
The AMCAS application typically opens during the first week of May each year for the following year's medical school class. • Explore your options for careers in medicine. • Get experience. • Plan and register for the MCAT. • Stay on track for medical school. • Look at resources. • Make plans with your advisor. • Letters of recommendation and required course work. • Prepare for medical school interviews.	Registration for the January-June 2024 test dates will open on Oct. 24 and 25 at noon ET. How often can I take the MCAT? Single testing year. Exam can be taken up to three times. Two consecutive year period. Exam can be taken up to four times. Lifetime: Exams can be taken up to seven times in a lifetime.
