Minimum Academic Requirements:

First Time Freshmen: Applicants must complete the KCSE with a cumulative grade point average of C+ (average of 50) in academic subjects at the secondary level.

Transfer: In order to be admitted in good standing, applicants must have an overall average of 45 (GPA of 2.0) and be in good standing with previous college/university.
