To declare a Minor in Music students must follow the procedures defined below:

1. **Apply to the Music Program** by completing the online application at: <https://www.wku.edu/music/music-app.php> Please select “Piano Pedagogy Minor” in the drop down menu titled “Intended College Major”.
2. **Select/Arrange an Audition Date.** Auditions for the upcoming Fall semester usually take place in February and are noted in the application. If you are already on campus and are submitting your application in the Fall Semester, the dates on the application may not apply; Email the advisor for alternate audition date options.
3. **Receive Audition Outcomes** (score and applied music eligibility). Audition outcomes will determine if you will or will not be accepted into the Piano Pedagogy Minor. Auditions serve to assess the student’s readiness for minor level applied lessons and courses.
4. Upon acceptance, **meet with the Piano Pedagogy Minor advisor** (listed on the following page) and complete the Change of Major/Minor form on TopNet.
5. **Register** for music course(s), ensembles(s), and lessons as advised.
