On Demand At a Glance

- Rolling admission and enrollment.
- Tuition must be paid at time of enrollment.
- In-state tuition rate regardless of residency.
- Self-pay or financial aid payment options.
- Study any time, any where.
- More than 80 courses available, including graduate courses.
- Developed and taught by WKU faculty
- Supplemental pay for teaching.
- Students have 9 months to complete the course with the option to purchase a 3 month extension.

Registration Dates

Spring Registration
December 1st - April 30th

Summer Registration
May 1st- July 31st

Fall Registration
August 1st-November 30th

- Courses start the day they enroll
- Students have 1 week to drop at 100% refund and 6 weeks with 75% refund.
- Students can withdraw from an On Demand course within 4 months.
- If a student does not complete the course within the timeframe an F is received.
- To repeat a failed course with On Demand, department head approval must be given.
- All On Demand courses are listed as restricted.



Financial Aid and On Demand

Students may enroll in WKU On Demand courses that can be taken via web.

The WKU On Demand Agreement is a contract between the Department of Student Financial Assistance, the enrolled WKU student, and the WKU On Demand Office. This agreement determines if a student is eligible to utilize financial aid to cover the cost of his/her WKU On Demand courses.

Students who complete a WKU On Demand Agreement with the Department of Student Financial Assistance should complete the On Demand course(s) within the semester for which financial aid is awarded. Students who receive federal financial aid to cover the cost of their On Demand courses should complete the course within the semester time frame. This is because students who sign the agreement and fail to complete their On Demand courses within their semester may be placed on financial aid probation or possibly risk losing their financial aid eligibility.

In order to use your Financial Aid to pay for a WKU on demand class, you must complete the "WKU On Demand/Financial Aid Request for Registration" form under your Financial Aid tab on TopNet.

Students must be enrolled in good standing in a degree-seeking program in order to be eligible for financial aid. In addition, students must be enrolled at least half-time to be eligible to apply for federal student loans.

Since the charges for On Demand course(s) are completely separate from regular university course charges, they are not considered in a determination of full-time hours for fee assessment purposes. For more information, visit [WKU On Demand's](#) website.

Remember, if you are using Financial Aid to pay for On Demand courses, you MUST complete it two weeks prior to the end of the semester in order to maintain your Financial Aid eligibility.



Tuition and Fees and Timeframe

FULL-TIME UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

- Fully Online Students (Web and/or on demand)**
- No full-time rate for online learners
 - Charged applicable tuition rate (On Demand or Web) for all hours taken
 - Web = DL Rate
 - On Demand (OD) = Current In-State Per Credit Hour Rate

- Web + Face-to-Face (F2F):**
- Full-time undergraduate students who enroll in a combination of face-to-face classes + Web will be charged the applicable in-state or out-of-state tuition rate for 12-18 hours.

- On Demand + F2F and/or Web:**
- FT undergrad students enrolled in 12 credit hours: Those who enroll in a combination of on demand + faceto-face and/or Web classes are charged per credit hour, based on class type (face-to-face, Web or on demand) for all hours taken up to 12 credit hours.
 - FT undergrad students enrolled in more than 12 credit hours of F2F or Web + an on demand class(es) are charged the applicable full-time tuition rate + per credit hour rate for the additional on demand class(es).

PART-TIME UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

Part-time undergrad students enrolling in a combination of delivery modes are charged the per credit hour rate for each course, based on course type.

- **On Demand Courses:** The per credit hour rate for in-state undergrad students is always charged, regardless of location (no out of state tuition is ever charged).
- **Web Courses:** The per credit hour Web course rate is always charged, regardless of location (no out of state tuition is ever charged).
- **Face-to-Face Courses:** The applicable in-state/out-of-state per credit hour rate is charged.

Graduate Students

There is no full-time rate for graduate students. Those who enroll in in a combination of web, On Demand or face-to-face are charged per credit hour based on class type. On Demand graduate courses are charged the current web rate.

Timeframe after initial enrollment*

- 1 week** Last day to drop an On Demand course w/out a grade. Last day to receive a 100% refund for a course.
- 6 weeks** Last day to receive a 75% refund with a grade of W. Last day to transfer to another On Demand course.
- 4 months** *Last day to withdrawal with a grade of W*
- 9 months** Last day to complete an On Demand course. May purchase a 3 month extension for \$75 to continue.
- Failure to complete an On Demand course by this date or purchase an extension will result in a grade of F.*
- 9 + 3 months** Last day to complete an On Demand course for which an extension has been granted, no exceptions.

***Your initial enrollment date is the date on which On Demand processes your registration request.**

Special Tuition Rates

On Demand honors the KY Educator rate of \$350.00 per credit hour.

We also honor the military rate of \$250.00 per credit hour.

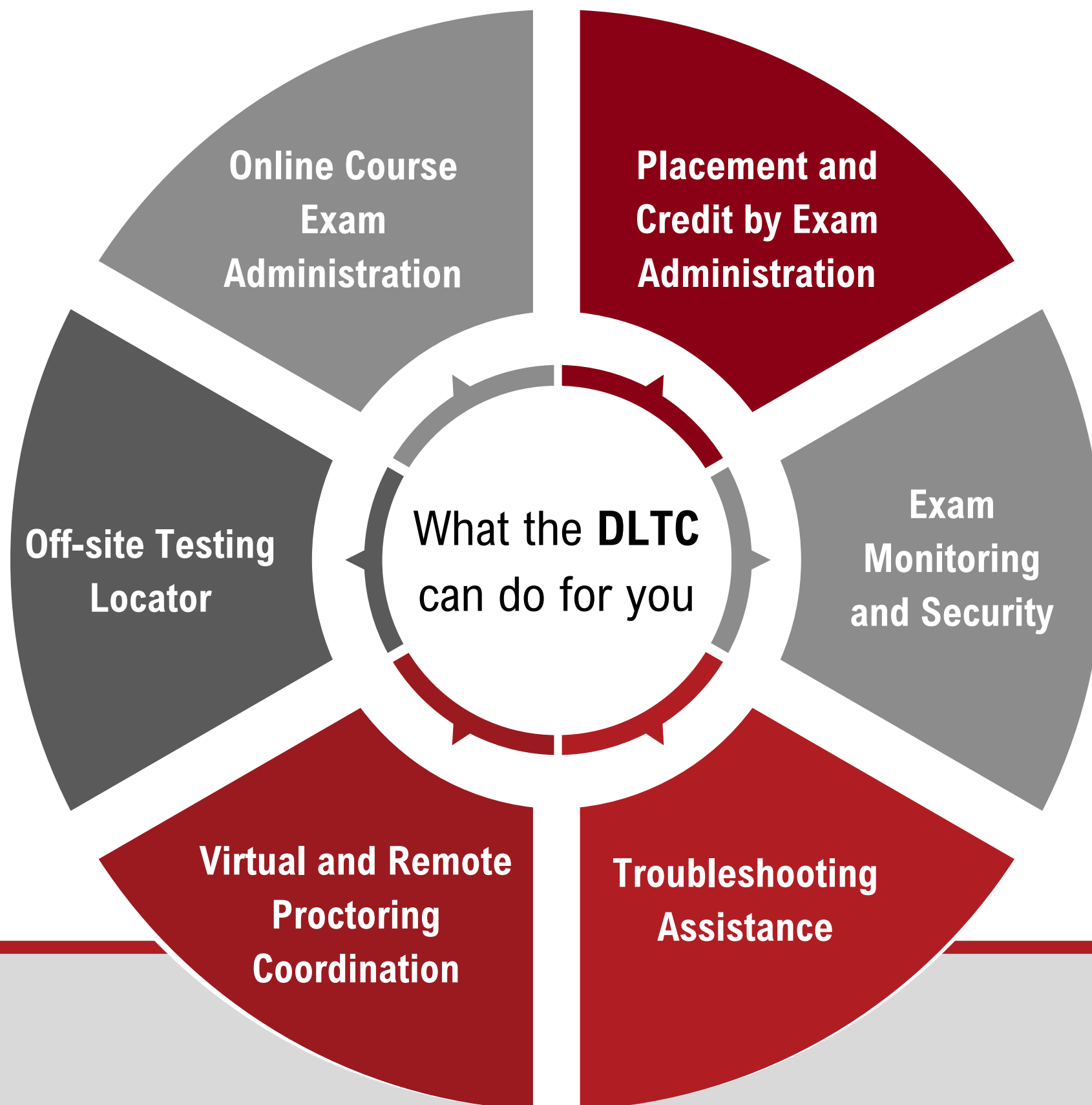
