Military Deployments for International Experience Appeal

For WKU baccalaureate, degree seeking students who also serve or have served in the military

Policy:

Undergraduate, degree-seeking military member and Veteran students who have served in a foreign country, outside of the United States for at least 90 days (consecutive or non-consecutive) may be eligible to use that experience to fulfill the Colonnade Connections – International Experience category. To submit a request for category fulfillment, students should complete the "Military Deployment for International Experience" form and submit it to the Office of the Registrar. The Committee on Credits and Graduation will review the form, and the Office of the Registrar will communicate with the student regarding the approval or denial of the request. Students do not receive credit hours nor residency for the deployment; however, the international experience category will be met on the student's degree audit.

Process:

- 1. Students who are currently serving or have served in the military and were deployed for at least 90 days should complete the accompanying form, provide the required documentation, and submit the form, including the three required mini-essays, and all documents to the Office of the Registrar.
- 2. The Office of the Registrar will compile the information for the Committee on Credits and Graduation to review. The Committee will vote to approve or deny the credit.
- 3. The Office of the Registrar will communicate the approval or denial of the request to the student. Decisions made by the Committee on Credits and Graduation are final.
