IMPORTANCE OF USING THE APPROVED F&A RATE:

- While F&A is associated with costs that are "indirectly" associated with the project, there is a real cost to the university to conduct research and other projects that use institutional infrastructure and resources, from facilities maintenance, to utilities, to personnel, and more. Simply put, externally funded projects cannot be conducted without incurring indirect costs. When failing to include the approved F&A rate, the burden of these costs falls to the university to support.
- Reducing and/or waiving the approved F&A rate on projects can negatively impact

assessments/negotiations when determining future F&A rates for the university.
